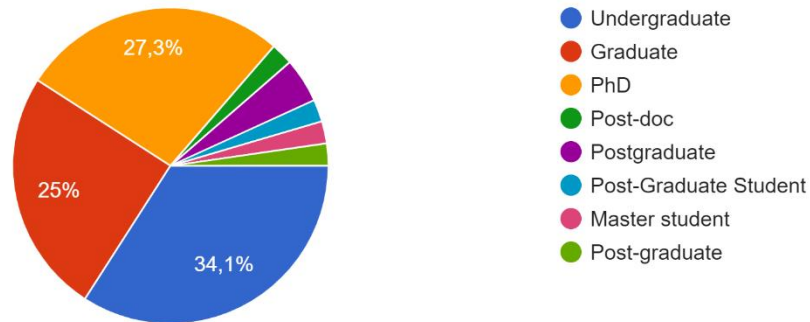

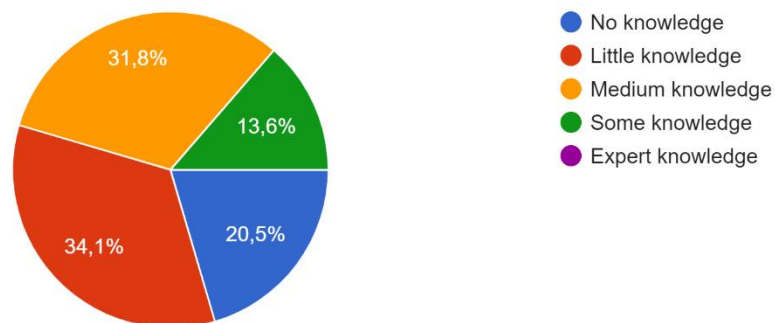
Your current level

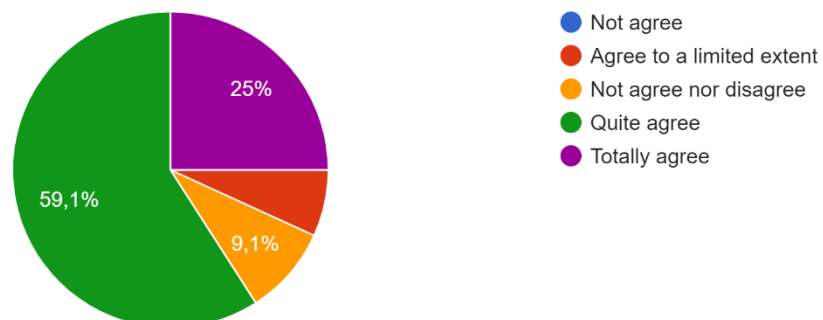
Did you have any previous knowledge of Fuzzy Cognitive Mapping before this course?

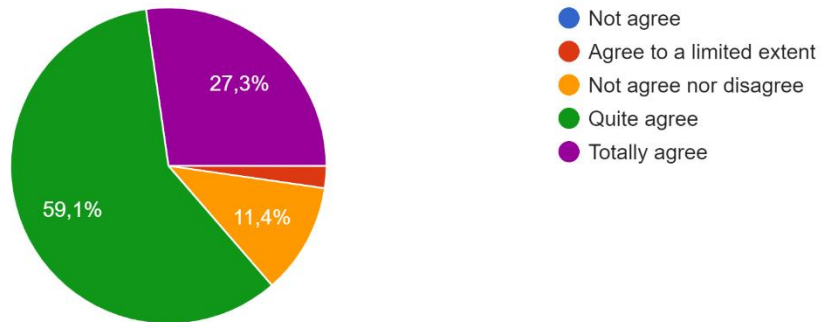
The FCM tools used in this course are useful for discussing and assessing the multiple aspects of the topic addressed.

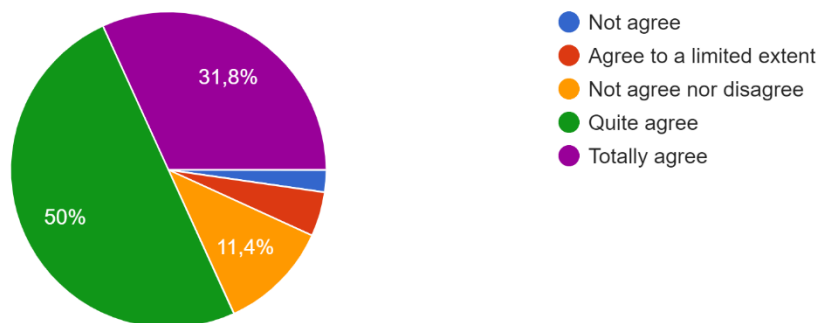
The FCM tool is easy to use.

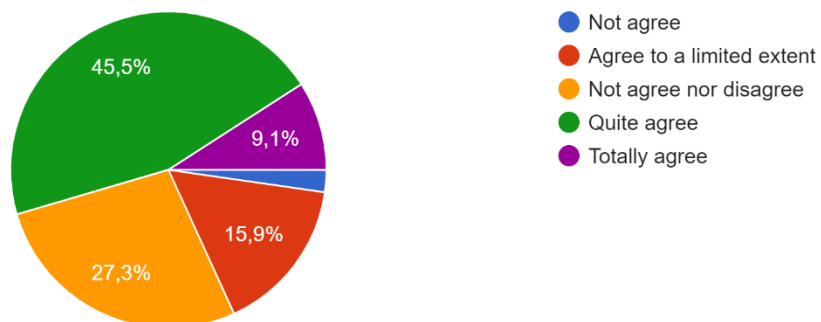
The FCM methodology fosters interdisciplinary work.

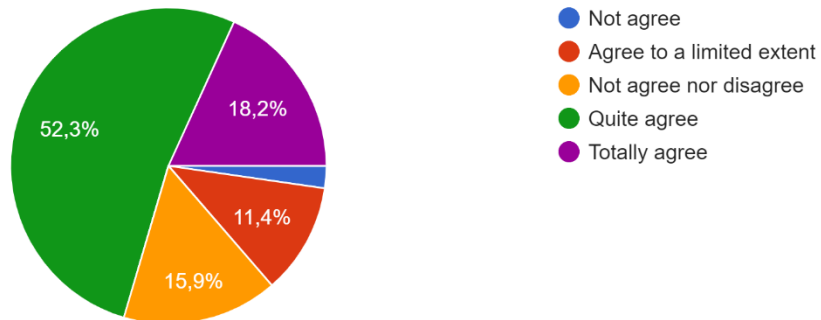

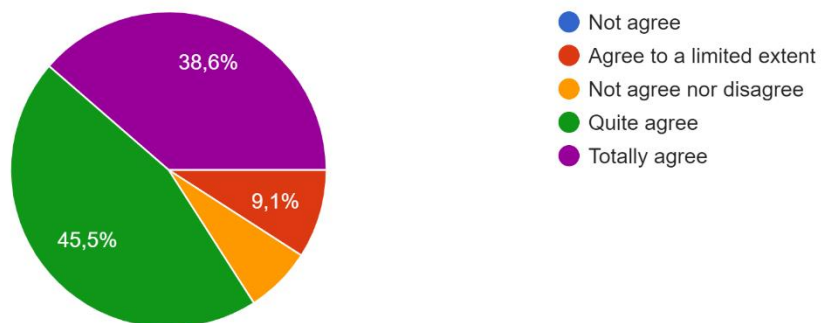

Please add some suggestions or comments about how to improve this kind of activity.

- I really like the way in which this activity has been organized. It's a pity that we had to be separated from the participants of other countries, but that was because of the sanitary situation. Despite that, we have had the opportunity to interact with each other during the sessions, so for me it has been better than what I expected at first. My only suggestion is to keep doing this kind of activity, because I believe that it has been a very productive experience and that all of us, from the youngest undergraduates to the organizers, have learnt a lot. Thank you for all the job that is behind this activity, I hope that everyone has enjoyed this experience as much as I have done.
- If it weren't for COVID, I think the conversation would be more multifaceted and culturally mixed, which would allow for even more elaborate conversations.
- The program has limited potential and doesn't help with any scientific research
- Although I gained some new methodological knowledge and social experiences, I think that there are some things that could be improved. Firstly, I strongly believe that it would be more effective if the program also included a session of presentations of transhumance cases or preservation of transhumance sites, from each country. In that way we could gain more information about the phenomenon of transhumance and be more sufficient in later taking the case studies into the mental modeler. And lastly, I would be really interested in actually meeting a person that used to be a moving shepherd, as part of a field trip. Thank you and I hope this will be helpful.
- A bit more planning would have been better, although I am usually happy finishing my day a little earlier than expected. This also applies to my group too, though the structure outside the daily workshop can be much looser it would have been nice to have something of a plan for dinner/hangouts, even if it was just twice in the week, but it's understandable given Covid (I'm not sure anyone really believed we were going until the night before the flight).
- The flow of information between coordinators and students was sometimes a bit hectic, so if I were to improve anything it would be to make general information a bit more accessible.
- Better explanation from the outset of how the FCM exercises carried out in the workshop related to the PECUS project, i.e. what outcomes were desired, either in terms of the model outputs or the student experience the organizers were hoping for.
- It would be wonderful to have a central location of the contact information of everyone involved, so we can communicate before we arrive, and to make it easy to contact each other after the activity ends.
- FCM would be more meaningful when it is used in a community, not in the academic environment. Also in this model always one person's opinion has more impact compared to others. There're, this priority will problematize its purpose as an interdisciplinary, participatory aim.
- I think that the organisation was phenomenal. My only suggestion would be to spend more time on the field when we visited the village. I take this opportunity to send enormous thanks to the organisers. It's been a great week and this is all thanks to them!
